# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)



#### **PROGRAM**

#### What can students expect?

The Leadership Program includes 20 Spanish classes per week, along with leadership and entrepreneurship masterclasses and workshops in English, held Monday to Friday at our Enforex Camp in Madrid.

At lunchtime, participants from other programs (Spanish and English language courses), aged 5–18, will come together to interact

In the afternoons, all participants will engage in age-appropriate activities, workshops, excursions, and sports, providing them with opportunities to practice their new skills in a multicultural environment.

#### **ACCOMMODATIONS**

#### Food options on campus?

We offer a balanced diet with buffet-style meals, which may vary depending on the age group and the day's activities.

### Can the program accommodate special dietary needs?

We can accommodate most special dietary requirements. If a student has food allergies or other dietary needs, please inform us in detail before arrival.

### How are room assignments determined?

Counselors assign rooms based on age, gender, nationality, and preferences expressed by Leadership Program participants.

### MEDICAL ASSISTANCE & MEDICATION SUPPORT

#### Medical personnel on campus?

Each campus has a nurse's office with staff available to assist students with medical needs.

### How should medication be handled?

Please inform us in writing about any medical needs and provide clear written instructions for the storage and administration of medication.

#### Can students with disabilities, chronic illnesses, or behavioral disorders enroll in the Leadership Program?

Please contact us to discuss the student's specific situation. Admissions decisions are made on a case-by-case basis.

#### **ACADEMICS**

#### What is the class schedule?

Spanish classes take place five days a week from 09:00 to 13:00. Leadership workshops in English are held from 15:00 to 17:00, three times a week.

### How many students are in each class?

A maximum of 15 students per class.

### How are students placed into classes? Is there a placement test?

Students will take an online Spanish placement test before arrival.

#### **ACTIVITIES**

#### Counselor-to-student ratio?

There are 2 counselors for every 12–15 students.

#### How do Permission days work?

Students born in or before 2010 can leave the campus at designated times set by the coordinator only if their parent/guardian has provided written authorization. Students may leave the campus only on scheduled Permission Days.

#### Do students have free time?

Students participate in organized activities and workshops throughout the day, but they have free time to relax, especially after lunch and during snack time.



# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

### TRANSFERS & LOGISTICS

#### How do transfers work?

Flight information for both arrival and departure must be submitted at least one week before arrival. Our staff will meet the student in the arrivals hall. If an unaccompanied minor service has been booked, please inform us so we can provide details of the assigned pickup staff.

### How does insurance work? What happens in case of illness or injury?

Students are covered by travel insurance. If a student becomes ill or requires medical attention, our staff will accompany them to a hospital to receive the necessary care.

### How can students receive money from their parents?

We recommend that students bring  $\in$  150 for each 2-week program, as all food and housing needs are covered. If additional funds are required, please contact us for instructions. In most cases, money can be sent via Western Union.

### Where can students keep their money and passport?

Counselors can securely store students' passports for the duration of the program (this is optional but recommended).

There is also a campus "bank" where students can deposit money and withdraw what they need each day.

### TECHNOLOGY & COMMUNICATION

### Can students bring cell phones or electronic devices?

Yes, but mobile device use is supervised and limited to encourage social interaction and engagement in the program. We are not responsible for the loss or damage of any electronic device.

### How can students stay in contact with their families?

Students can access their mobile devices when needed to contact their families. The campus phone number is for urgent matters only. On arrival day, students will be encouraged to call their parents to share their first-day experience.

### PROGRAM POLICIES & PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT

### Can I change the dates of my reservation?

Yes, changes can be made up to one week before the program starts, subject to availability.

### Can parents accompany students to the campus?

Parents may accompany students to the university campus on the first day. However, please note that staff and counselors will be busy welcoming new students and may not be available for meetings.

### RULES & CONDUCT

This is an international program attended by students from diverse nationalities, cultures, and religions.

At Enforex, respect for others and program rules is essential to ensure a positive experience for all participants.

Failure to follow the rules may result in expulsion without a refund.

#### **Program Rules:**

- Respect others at all times, including fellow students and staff.
- Respect personal property—stealing money or belongings is strictly prohibited.
- Engage in positive social behavior.
- Students are not allowed to visit rooms of the opposite sex during break times.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited.
